PHASE DECISION POINTS a. Close school facilities for in-person instruction; provide all instruction via remote learning. **b.** Continue school meal programs with provisions. c. Conduct board meetings virtually. **d.** Suspend extracurricular activities / field trips / sports / student volunteer programs. e. Allow essential / critical staff to return following CDC and DOH guidelines; limit access to buildings. Provide tools for other staff to work remotely. a. Devise Board-approved health and safety plan prior to providing any in-person services to students. b. Implement required staff training on health and safety plan prior to providing in-person services to students. c. Plan for acclimation of student reentry and / or addressing socio-emotional needs of students. d. Implement Continuity of Education instructional options, based on local circumstances (e.g., confirmed case(s); local decisions, etc.) and PDE guidance: • Continue face-to-face instruction with additional precautionary measures implemented. Institute a modified / hybrid delivery system, (e.g., staggered schedules, combination of in-person and online instruction). e. Suspend student volunteer activities. f. Determine procedures for extracurricular activities / field trips / sports. g. Suspend non-essential student and staff travel. h. Limit staff meetings to groups of no larger than 25; adhere to CDC guidelines for meetings. i. Restrict use of cafeteria; limit cafeteria services. Adhere to guidance from PDE and DOH regarding face coverings for staff, students, families, visitors, and contractors in classrooms, in common areas, and on transportation vehicles. k. Specific requirements for transportation will be determined between school districts and bus contractors. I. Begin use of other personal protective equipment as directed. m. Require staff, students, parents, visitors, and contractors to conduct self-wellness checks prior to entering buildings, including answering the following questions: Have you experienced any of the following in the last 24-48 hours: fever, shortness of breath, chills, dry cough, or contact with someone who has tested positive and / or is under investigation for COVID-19? Have you returned from international travel within the last 14 days? n. Restrict access to buildings; do not allow access for volunteers. o. Handle confirmed or suspected cases of COVID-19 by sending staff or student home; follow CDC guidance for next steps. p. Implement protocols for handling of cases of exposure and possible exposure. q. Implement additional cleaning and disinfecting protocols. Implement clean desk policy for employees. Provide cleaning and disinfecting supplies for staff. In case of resurgence, close building and deep clean after 24 hours. Consider offering childcare services, and if so, require temperature checks for students upon arrival. a. Devise Board-approved health and safety plan prior to providing any in-person services to students. b. Implement required staff training on health and safety plan prior to providing in-person services to students. c. Plan for acclimation of student reentry and / or addressing socio-emotional needs of students. d. Open school facilities for in-person instruction and services with implemented health and safety precauationary measures. e. Provide virtual offering for students / families who opt for remote learning due to safety / health concerns. f. Require staff, students, parents, visitors, and contractors to conduct self-wellness checks prior to entering buildings, including answering the following questions: Have you experienced any of the following in the last 24-48 hours: fever, shortness of breath, chills, dry cough, or contact with someone who has tested positive and / or is under investigation for COVID-19? Have you returned from international travel within the last 14 days? g. Implement / continue daily deep-cleaning and sanitation procedures in buildings with increased cleaning of high touch point areas. h. Educate staff and students on social distancing practices (do not share items, maintain safe distances, etc.). i. Adhere to guidance from PDE and DOH regarding face coverings for staff, students, families, visitors, and contractors in classrooms, in common areas, and on transportation vehicles. Specific requirements for transportation will be determined between school districts and bus contractors. k. Restrict events to 250 attendees or less. Establish procedures for cafeteria use. m. Implement cleaning and safety protocols for transportation services. n. Handle confirmed or suspected cases of COVID-19 by sending staff or student home; follow CDC quidance for next steps.

Disclaimer: As educational leaders devise reentry plans and make decisions, the health and well-being of students and staff members remains, as always, the top priority. While there is not a 'one size fits all' model for reopening and / or responding to a resurgence, this document captures the collaborative decisions made across Berks County Schools. As guidance evolves, decisions may be amended or changed.
